George Cash, Jr. was born May 5, 1924 to his parents George Cash, Sr. and Rosie Lee Pink Cash. He attended Cresant Junior High School where his Uncle T. L. Pink was the Principal.

George played sports in school from baseball to basketball. He graduated from Wharton High School at the age of 18, and was living in Spanish Camp, Texas.

George married the love of his life, Cora Lee Coleman, after High School and moved to Texas City, Texas in 1944.

He started working construction. He also worked at Mahaffey Motors and Bertollett Dodge dealerships in Texas City. He was the only transmission man in Galveston County. He eventually opened his own shop called Cash's Car Clinic, family owned, in 1979 on Texas Avenue in Texas City. He specialized in transmission repair.

The joy of his life was with his family and friends. He taught his sons and some of his grandsons the skills of mechanic work. This was their favorite place of gathering together through the week. Westward Street Club was where he met with most of his friends, walking in with a smile on his face.

He loved going to rodeos, seeing his son riding wild horses and bulls. He enjoyed life to the fullest with God's blessings

George was a faithful member of the Greater Barbours Chapel Baptist Church, where he served in the Choir and Male Chorus. He also served under the leadership of Rev. H. A. Ratcliff, Rev. James Brown, Rev. Andrew Berry, II and his loving Pastor, Pastor Kenneth Cotton.

On January 31, 2026, at the age of 101, George was called from labor to reward at HCA Hospital in Texas City with his family at his bedside.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his loving wife- Cora Lee Cash, a daughter-Moretta Cash Philips, sons-Wilbur Cash and George Cash, III, grandson-Ronald Cash. His siblings-Josephine Cobb, Tommie Z. Williams, Ike Cash and Jessie Cash.
