On June 10, 1944 in Galveston Texas, a handsome baby boy was born to Lillie Belle Heggins and Anthony Allen Proctor. They named their precious baby Jimmie Alan Proctor.

Jimmie was educated in the public schools of Lamarque Texas and was a graduate of Lincoln High School – Class of 1962. He then enlisted in the United States Navy and made his career. His career spanned for 20 years until he retired in 1985 as a Peacetime and Vietnam War Veteran. After retiring, he went on to continue his education and received a Vocational Certificate in Vocational in Mechanics. He also worked as a driver for a

hyperbaric chamber facility shortly after returning to Texas.. After his full retirement, he enjoyed playing dominos and cards with friends and visiting with his great grandchildren.

Jimmie later made his home in Pensacola, Florida in March 2022, where he resided until he entered into his eternal rest on Wednesday, November 9, 2022 at Ascension Sacred Heart Hospital at the age of 78. 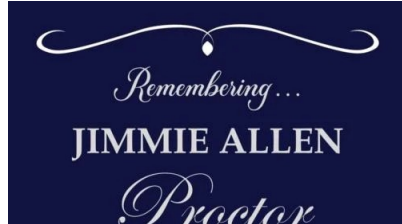
