He taught them moral values; to be respectful with our tongue, wisdom to accept positive advice and to be humble in our actions.

Whenever Quincy was not working, he took pride in his appearance. Always neatly dressed from head to toe with his shoes so shiny you could almost see your reflection. 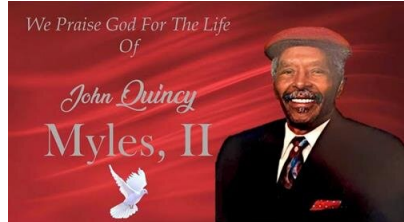
