



## Larry Joseph Richardson

### Obituary

Larry Joseph Richardson also known as “Richie and Brown Sugar” was born in De Queen Arkansas, to Frank Nelson and Estell Richardson on June 12, 1947.

He attended the public schools of De Queen AR and completed his education in LaMarque TX graduating from Lincoln High School.

Larry accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Greater Macedonia Baptist Church under the late Rev. S. A. Anderson. He later attended Abundant Life Christian Center in LaMarque.

In 1965 Larry enlisted into the United States Army where he served 3 years. During his tour of duty, he was deployed to Vietnam for eleven months. He was a member for over 25 years before he retired.
