On September 9, 1958 in Crowley, Louisiana, a handsome baby boy was born to the union of John H. Washington and Edith M. Green Washington. They named their blessing, Lynn June Washington.

"Big June" as he was fondly known by his family and friends, was educated in the public schools of Galveston, Texas. He was a 1977 graduate of Ball High School, Galveston, Texas where he was a member of the Basketball team and an exceptional athlete. After graduation, he attended Blinn College in Brenham, Texas.

"Big June" was a Correctional Officer with TDCJ in Galveston and worked 37 years before his retirement. He never met a stranger, and if you knew him, you had to love him. He was a longtime member of Abundant Life Christian Center in La Marque under the leadership of Pastor Walter Hallam. While attending, he served in many ministries including the children's and youth departments. Working in the ministry was very important to him.

"Big June" loved spending time with his family and friends, and was known for showing acts of kindness towards others. He was a "Gentle Giant!"

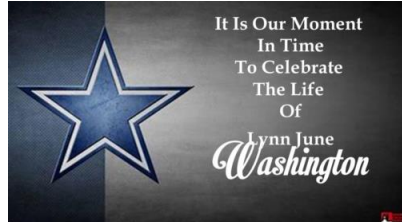
