Wilfred Robinson is the oldest of 6 children born in Eunice, LA, to Mary and Wilman Robinson.

His Mom and Dad brought the family to Galveston, TX, in early 1950s. He attended public schools in Galveston graduating from Central High School in 1964 where he “tried out” for the Central Bearcats Football Team.

Upon graduation, he served in the United States Army in October of 1967 at 21 years of age and was stationed in Fort Polk, Louisiana. He fought in the Vietnam War. He was a proud and dedicated Veteran and was adamant about attending weekly functions with army veteran buddies. After being honorably discharged from the US Army, he gained employment as a laborer for many years. Wilfred served as an usher with the Queen of Peace Catholic Church in La Marque, Tx under the Leadership of Father Anderson.

He loved listening to music, dancing, and having fun playing cards at family functions. He especially enjoyed hanging out under the tree with friends and weekly outings at his favorite night spots!

He was preceded in death by his mother and father, Mary and Wilman Robinson, as well as his sisters, Mary Jane and Marylene Robinson.

He is survived by a sister, Lorena Green; brothers, Wilbert Robinson, Sr. (Cynthia), and Gilbert Robinson (Gia); wife, Shirley; and stepdaughter, Vickie Johnson; other nieces, nephews, cousins, relatives and friends.
